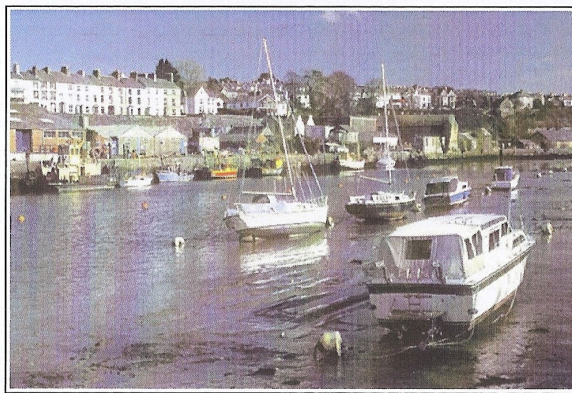

Day One

After being collected from your homes and joining the tour coach at Melton Mowbray, we settle down after having met our fellow passengers for the leisurely journey. A comfort stop will be made at 'Staperley Water Gardens'. After this break we rejoin our coach and continue our journey, joining the A55 near Chester along the North Wales Coast to Caernarfon and our hotel, The Celtic Royal Hotel or Gwesty'R Celt. Time now to familiarise yourselves with the facilities of this hotel, have a stroll or perhaps a drink before our evening meal. Its time to relax and have a leisurely evening.

Day Two

Enjoy a Full Welsh Breakfast in the hotel. Today we'll discover the mountain of 'Snowdonia National Park'. On our tour we will stop off at the interesting 'Indigo Jones' slate works, followed by a trip to Betws-y-Coed on our return to Caernarfon, time now to relax and enjoy dinner, followed by a cosy evening with entertainment.

A morning tour of Anglesey and a stop for lunch. Afternoon visit to the 'must see' Castle of Caernarfon, one of the finest castles ever built, with perhaps a visit to the 'Welsh Tweed Mills' at Llanesk Park, St Asaph and then return for our evening meal.

Today we say our goodbyes to Wales and after a leisurely breakfast we start our homeward journey. We will have a visit to either Shrewsbury or Chester arriving back in Melton for 17.30 to connect with our homeward bound transport. After saying our fond farewells, goodbyes and perhaps stealing a good bye kiss! Its time to reflect on our visit and plans for Christmas, not so far away.

About Caernarfon: Caernarfon's walled town and castle is where the investiture of 'The Prince of Wales' took place. During our visit we will have seen the 'Snowdonia National Park' and 'The North Wales Coast' a spectacular coast of sandy beaches, headlands and estuaries. Its along this West Coast, that mountains meet the sea and charming villages abound. Here there are remains of a Roman Fort 'Segontium' where the Romans stayed but didn't quite conquer. The home of Kate Roberts, one of Wales' most celebrated writers is also near Caernarfon and is now a heritage centre. Remember Snowdonia is a mythical place and legend has it, spend a night on 'Cader Idris' (mountain) and you will either awake a poet or a madman - or not at all! Snowdonia's Mountain and Coast tell you so much about the real Wales. The Welsh language and descendant of the tongue we all once spoke in our islands is still in use today, so here are a few phrases for you to learn:
